

OPERATOR TRAINING A-SERIES PRINTERS

(Installation Training, Time: 2.5 to 3hrs approx)

Introductory Health & Safety:

- Wear glasses and gloves when working on the printer
- Avoid all sources of ignition
- Read MSDS for ink and wash
- Use operator pocket hand book during training.

Skills:

1. Start-up and shut-down of printer (explain why printer must be closed-down correctly).
2. When and how to change make-up cartridges (explain why make-up is needed, viscosity control and flushing).
3. When and how to change ink cartridges (explain why ink cartridges are required).
4. When and how to replace reservoirs (explain why reservoir requires changing and that there may be old ink still in the reservoir).
5. When and how to wash down print head (including charge electrode) and what faults relate to the print head.
6. When and how to align jet into gutter (explain why and when this may have to be done).
7. How to program in messages, print messages and save messages, if required.
8. How to adjust set-up's in 'print set-up menu' (delay, width, orientation).

Note: Items 4 and 6 may be carried out by maintenance people.
